ASSEMBLY DETAILS AND ROUTE

The Procession will assemble on the Marston Trading Estate. Local vehicle entries please enter the Estate via Sainsbury's. Non local vehicle entries must use the Frome By-Pass, coming into Frome from the Shepton Mallet roundabout on the B3090. Turn right at the Sainsbury's roundabout and left at the next roundabout. **Vehicles to assemble by 6.00 pm.** Entries arriving on foot should go to the Thomson's (Manor Road) car park by 6.15 pm. Procession commences at 7.00 pm. **PROCESSION ROUTE :** via the Butts, Butts Hill, Bath Street, Market Place, North Parade, Berkley Road, Badgers Hill and finishing at the Show Field. Vehicles may then continue to Brunel Way and park up.

JUDGING

Judging will take place during the Procession. Details of the judging procedure will be sent with your Class Cards on receipt of a completed entry form.

PRESENTATIONS

All Prize Cards, Trophies and Prize Money will be presented to the winning entries at the Frome Town Football Club after the Procession. The Trophies and Cups are to be held for one year. **All competitors are invited to attend, no tickets needed this year.**

- The entry judged to be the Overall Best from classes 9 and 11 will receive the **Frome Colts Juvenile Masqueraders Cup**
- The entry judged to have the Best Costumes from classes 1,2,3,4, & 5 will receive the **Frome Carnival Shield.**
- The Best Turned Out Local Majorette Troupe in the Procession will receive the **Rotary Polio Plus 1987 Shield.**

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY - EVENING PROCESSION

1. Completed Entry Forms should reach the Procession Secretary, Mrs. A Bishop, 78 Ashtree Road, Frome, (Telephone 01373 455234) by Saturday 28th August 2010 for entry into the Carnival Programme. Late Entries will be accepted up to and until 6pm on Carnival Day.
2. No entry will be allowed in the Procession unless approved by the Procession Chairman.
3. All classes will be marked on a points system. For classes 1 to 5 inc, 6 categories all out of 20 points, for class 6, 3 categories all out of 20 points, for classes 7 & 8, 6 categories all out of 20 points and for classes 9 to 12 inc, 4 categories all out of 20 points.
4. Frome Carnival Charities accept no liability for loss, damage or injury to any person, animal or property howsoever caused.
5. It is the responsibility of the participants to adequately insure their vehicle in the Procession and to ensure it is in a roadworthy condition. **Insurance and V S O documents will be checked prior to procession start.**
6. Vehicle entries are advised to observe the Wessex Code of Conduct for Carnival Floats.
7. A signature of the Organiser or Parent is required on the entry portion, accepting these conditions of entry.
8. All Carnival mounted entries will be inspected by the Procession Chairman or appointed body who will advise you on any health and safety issues. You may be asked to sign a disclaimer form.
9. **AS A COMMITTEE, THE FROME CARNIVAL COMMITTEE AND CHARITY ASSOCIATION ACCEPT NO RESPONSIBILITY FOR DRESS CODE COPYRIGHT OR MUSICAL COPYRIGHT.**
10. **IT IS THE SOLE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE ENTRY TO ENSURE THEY HOLD A LICENCE FOR THE PERFORMING RIGHTS SOCIETY IF THEY NEED IT.**
11. **Any Photographs images we have taken can be used for any publicity, i.e Our Web site etc.**
12. **In the event of it happening, but hopefully will not the following will apply as regards Penalty Points.**

10 points could be deducted for any of the following infringements of these rulings as assessed and determined by at least **three committee members**. Breaking of the speed limit in the line up area or dispersal area, and not obeying the marshals when requested to do any procedure in the same areas. Failure to inform a marshal of any problem during the procession, which causes a gap of more than 150 feet, where if informed the said marshal could hold up the procession.
